## the rev. molly bosscher, standing committee president:

And maybe you think about people who, you know, who would be good at this because we need strong and capable whose gifts are of discernment and who know and hear the Spirit.

Because I know without a doubt that this process moving forward is always and already colored with the gifts of the Spirit and the Spirit's presence among us, which every single time I talk to almost any of you all I see and I hear and I know with my very being.
